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### TRAIL PLAN LEGEND:

- OLD HOMESTEAD TRAIL: approx. 120 lineal feet**  
+ 4' wide Crushed Rock Trail with 8-12% +/- Accessibility, Views & Overlook at Old Home Site
- WILDLIFE VIEW WALK: approx. 180 lineal feet**  
+ 4' wide Handicap-Accessible Trail with Views & Overlook to High Wildlife Use areas
- IMPROVED 130TH STREET ENTRANCE AS NOTED**
- VIEWPOINT OR OVERLOOK AS NOTED**
- TEMPORARY MAINTENANCE TRAIL**

### TRAIL GOALS:

- 1. ENVIRONMENTALLY - SENSITIVE**
  - + Fit with Microtopography
  - + Utilize already Disturbed Area needing Habitat Restoration
  - + Provide 25'-50' Thornton Creek Buffer except at Bridges
- 2. INTERESTING, SCENIC, EXPERIENTIAL**
  - + Access a Variety of Features, Views & Experiences
  - + Create Opportunities for Environmental Education
- 3. ACCESSIBLE & SAFE**
  - + Provide Accessibility for All Ages, including as much Handicap Accessibility (5%-10% Grade) as possible
  - + Maintain Good Visibility along Trails for Safety & User Comfort
