
Active Zone (2 of 2) Tree Locations





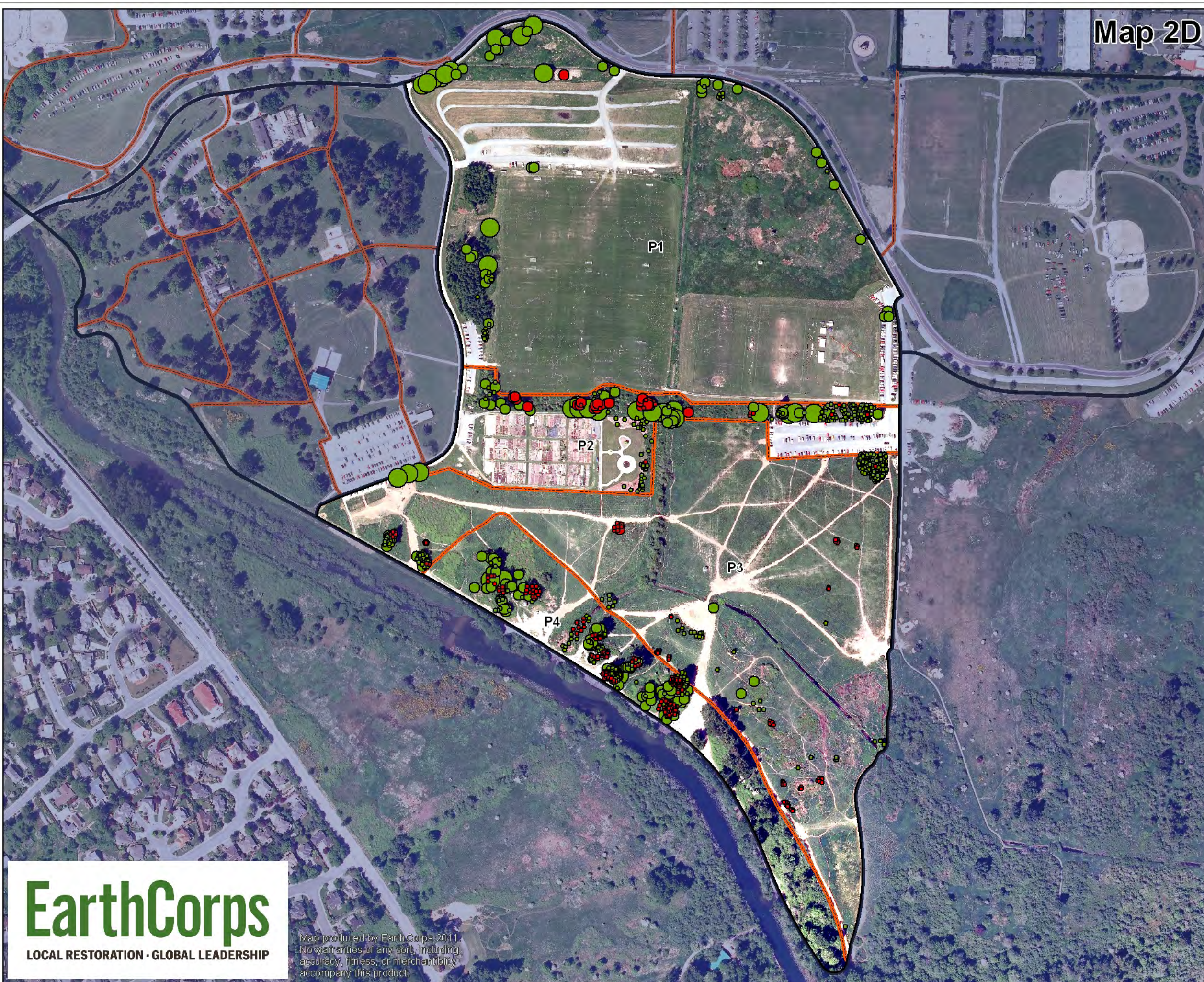

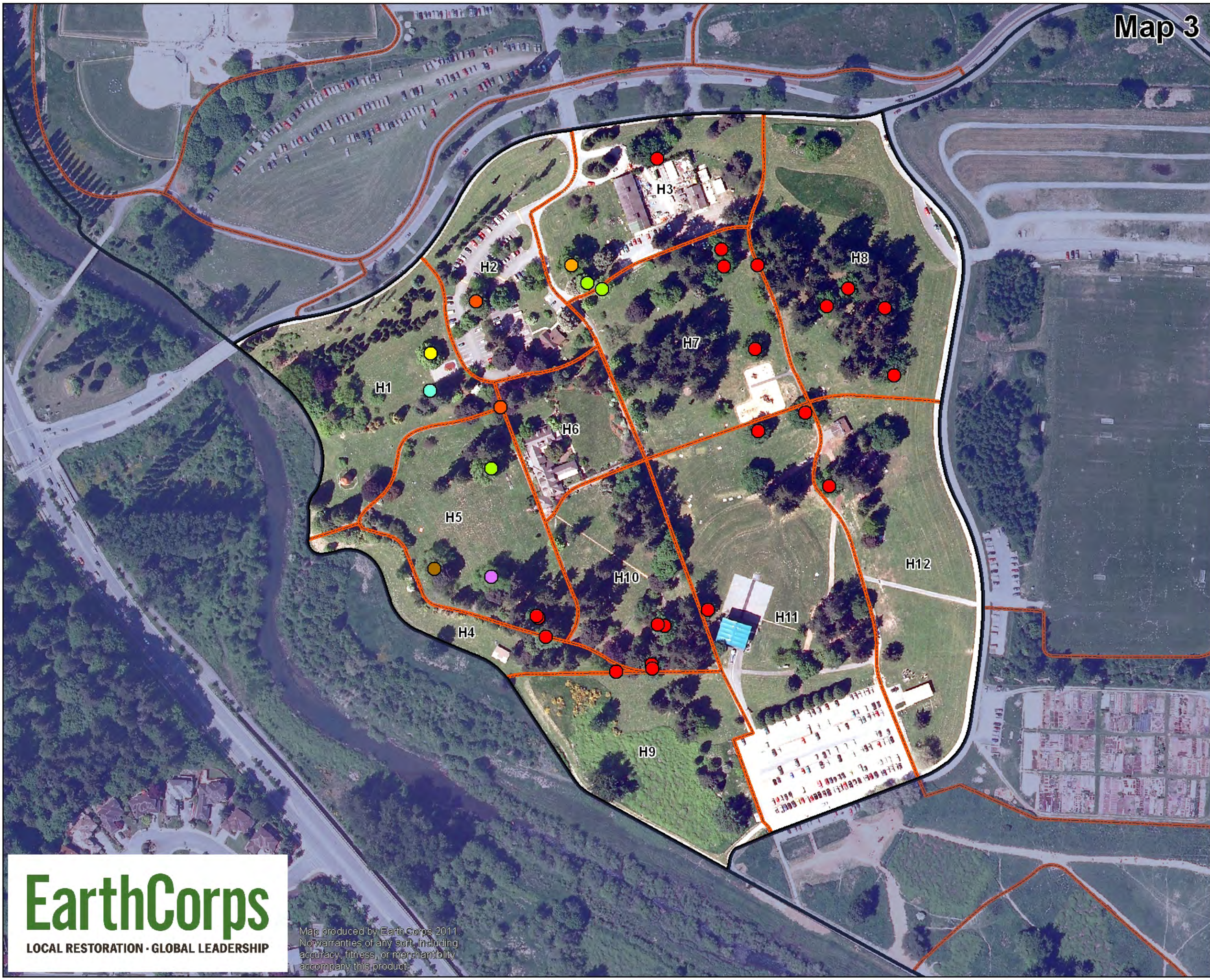

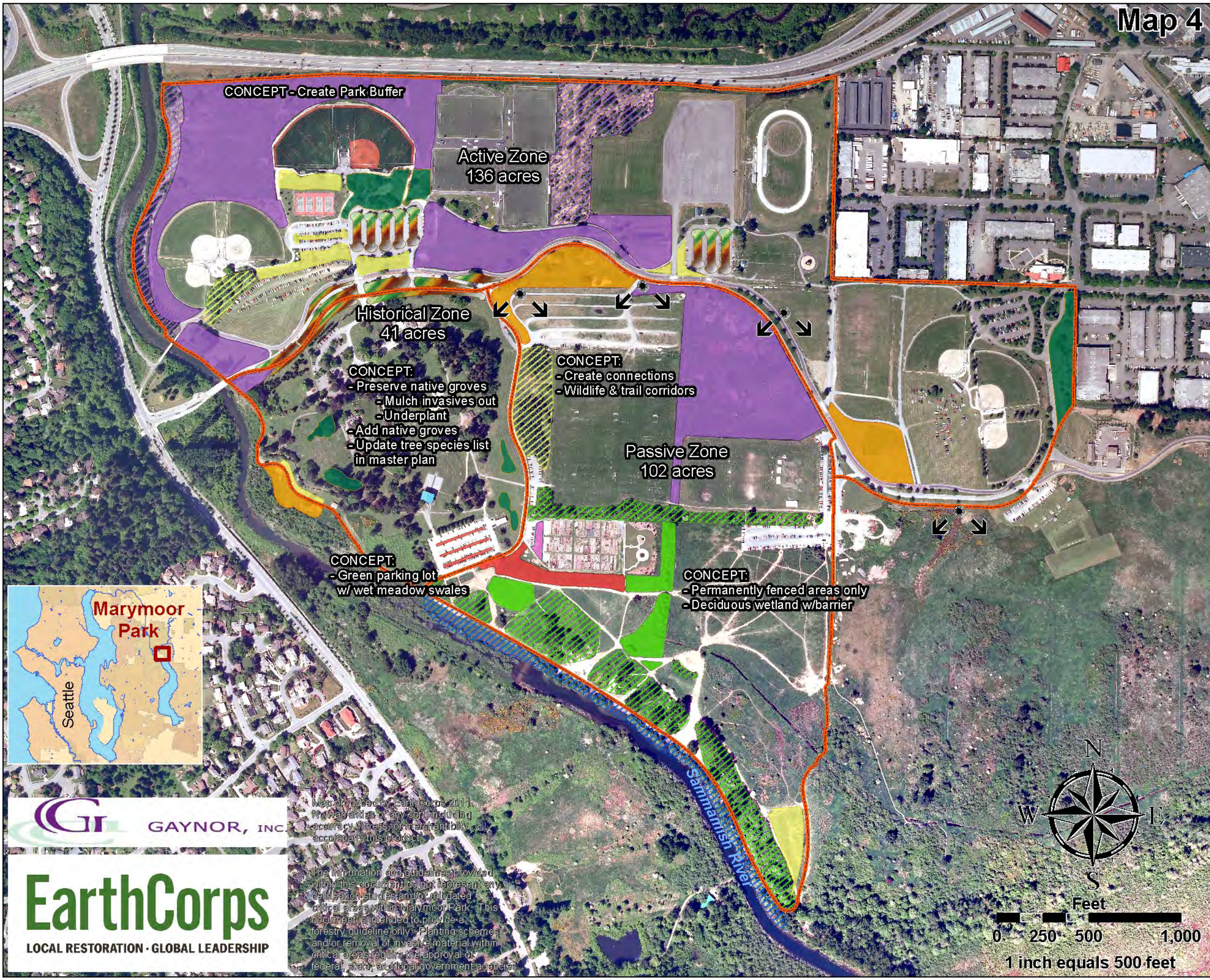
