

OUR WORK

Mill Creek Canyon

KENT, WA

In 2024, EarthCorps made significant strides in restoring Mill Creek Canyon - a cherished trail that meanders through an urban forest in the City of Kent. During the winter of 2021/2022, the trail suffered a destructive landslide, which jeopardized the structural integrity and accessibility. Recognizing the significance of Mill Creek Canyon, EarthCorps partnered with the city to develop and implement a comprehensive plan.

To address the damage, our crews successfully installed a 1,300-pound, 126-foot chute and a coordinated rope system to transport rock materials down the steep, 45-degree slope. Crews manually carried in all other materials, including 100-pound timbers that measured over eight feet long.

Mill Creek Canyon was incredibly labor-intensive. Teams removed an impressive six feet of saturated slip material and stabilized the area by constructing a massive four-tier log crib structure. Spanning 24

feet by 11 feet, this impressive build reconnected the north and south sections of the main trail, reinforcing it against future natural disasters while preserving the canyon's natural beauty.

Trail building involves constructing and improving trails with the primary goal of enhancing, protecting, or restoring a degraded natural area, such as Mill Creek Canyon, and requires careful site assessment and planning to avoid sensitive habitats, minimize erosion, and implement sustainable designs. Supporting this project, our Corps Members had the opportunity to dive into strategic and technical skills that not only prepare them for long-term green careers but also scale a diverse pipeline with a wide range of skills into green jobs.

OUR WORK

Longfellow Creek

SEATTLE, WA

In 2024, our dedicated crew at Longfellow embarked on a significant planting initiative, aimed at enhancing the greenspace nestled between the Delridge and High Point neighborhoods of West Seattle. This effort was critical not only for the ecological health of the region but also for the community it serves, as we implemented bi-weekly watering strategies for the newly planted areas most vulnerable to sun and drought.

“Due to the ongoing climate crisis, summer months are getting progressively hotter and dryer, and this is often fatal to young plants trying to get established amid an invasive seed bank. Cedar trees are especially vulnerable, and it’s not an uncommon sight to see a fried cedar sapling on freshly planted sites the moment summer gets into full swing.”

The Longfellow Creek Greenspace plays an increasingly vital role in the City of Seattle and the Green Seattle Partnership’s mission to foster a robust forest canopy, essential for mitigating the urban heat-island effects prevalent in this densely developed area. This greenspace stands as a green refuge within a landscape marked by

industrialization, serving diverse communities, including many immigrant populations, who call these neighborhoods home.

While the greenspace boasts a considerable tree canopy, it is predominantly composed of deciduous trees, with a concerning lack of mature conifers. The presence of conifer trees is a key indicator of a healthy, mature forest ecosystem. To address this, our planting efforts have focused on increasing the regenerating conifer layer, aiming to nurture a more balanced and resilient ecosystem.

We developed a new Scope of Work to guide our efforts into 2025. Our plans entail maintaining the areas we cultivated in 2024 while also initiating restoration in additional sections of Longfellow. This comprehensive approach will set the stage for future planting endeavors, reaffirming our commitment to enhancing this invaluable greenspace for both the environment and the community we serve.


Southgate Park

TUKWILA, WA

Southgate Park is an 11 acre urban green space in Tukwila that had been overtaken by ivy, blackberry, and other competitive non-native species leading to a large degree of canopy loss and native plant suppression.

EarthCorps restores forests and urban canopies, focusing on neighbors and communities that have been historically underserved and suffer most from the urban heat island effect. Southgate Park is vital - urban canopy cools neighborhoods through shade and evapotranspiration, and sequesters carbon that reduces atmospheric greenhouse gases.

In 2024, funding from the WA DNR grant allowed us to bring work in the park to prioritize saving the canopy and create space for continued restoration. Work will continue in 2025 with priority to riparian areas of the site and focus to improve water quality in the stream that empties into the Duwamish River, stabilize the banks to prevent erosion and flooding, and continue vegetation management - caring for native species and manually removing non-native invasive plants that outcompete native plants.



What is an Urban Heat Island?

An urban heat island (UHI) effect is observed in metropolitan areas where temperatures are notably higher than in surrounding rural areas, particularly during the summer and at night. This phenomenon arises from the replacement of natural land cover with heat-absorbing materials such as asphalt and concrete, combined with human activities and building density that restrict airflow. The UHI effect contributes to increased energy consumption for cooling, elevated air pollution levels, and poses significant health risks, especially during heat waves.



OUR PROGRAMS

Our Corps Program

At EarthCorps, our unique Corps training emphasizes education and training, vital components of our Corpsmember (CM) experience. In 2024, CMs dedicated approximately 20% of their time, amounting to about 2,556 hours, to structured educational activities.

The year commenced with an intensive two-week orientation covering essential topics such as EarthCorps 101, restoration techniques, risk assessment, and community building. Our curriculum is designed around three core pillars: Community, Leadership, and Habitat. This approach fosters both hard and soft skills, allowing participants not only to learn but also to share their knowledge through capstone projects and anti-racist working group (ARWG) projects.

Throughout the year, we focused heavily on Community and Leadership during workshops and retreats. Initial activities aimed at rapport building facilitated community development and a deeper understanding of leadership, conflict management, and interpersonal interactions. Early habitat workshops ensured that CMs received vital field training and certifications, laying the groundwork for their practical roles.

As we transitioned to emphasize habitat skills, workshops addressed environmental justice and climate anxiety, equipping CMs with tools to foster sustainability and navigate challenging topics.

The ARWG projects enabled members to research and present on environmental justice, enhancing their public speaking skills and deepening their engagement with critical issues.

Capstone projects further allowed CMs to apply their field skills to plan restoration initiatives, conducting ecological assessments and developing actionable grant proposals. These collaborative efforts culminated in presentations that showcased their hard work and innovative solutions.

Our program also featured three retreats, functioning as key reflection checkpoints. These overnight events provided vital opportunities for introspection and future planning, enriching the overall Corps experience.

Through our comprehensive education and training initiative, EarthCorps empowers members with essential skills, fostering a strong sense of community and commitment to environmental stewardship.

STORIES FROM OUR COMMUNITY

Community & Volunteer Team Highlight

In 2024, EarthCorps' Community and Volunteer (CV) Team experienced remarkable growth, deepening its partnerships with BIPOC students and communities across the region. Building on the successful foundation established at Foster High School in Tukwila, the team expanded its model to nine additional high schools in Burien, Tukwila, and South Seattle.

Working closely with local organizations and school faculty, the CV Team co-designed experiential learning and outdoor activities that spoke directly to the interests and needs of BIPOC youth. These programs offered students meaningful, hands-on opportunities—whether through our internship program, collaborating with EarthCorps crews on ecological restoration, or engaging in culturally relevant outdoor experiences.

Fourteen youth joined Tribal peers in Port Gamble, creating opportunities for cross-cultural learning, while summer camping trips in the San Juan Islands deepened their sense of belonging in nature. A standout moment came when more than 350 students gathered for a large-scale restoration event at Red Barn Ranch, coming together in a powerful demonstration of environmental stewardship and community building.

The year also marked a significant expansion in partnerships. The CV Team grew from collaborating with four to fourteen BIPOC-led organizations, forging connections with groups dedicated to urban farming, outdoor education, capacity building, and community event design.

Each new partnership brought fresh perspectives and expertise, strengthening the team's ability to deliver programming that is both culturally relevant and deeply impactful.

Through these efforts, EarthCorps is not only restoring the environment but also cultivating the next generation of environmental leaders—young people who are rooted in their communities, inspired by nature, and ready to shape a more equitable future.


